



A Message from Birdville ISD

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Through your support and passage of the 2022 Bond Program, Birdville ISD will be building a new campus on the Haltom Road, David E. Smith Elementary site that will house both David E. Smith and W.T. Francisco Elementary students. The combined campus will be named David E. Smith Elementary and is scheduled to open in the fall of 2025.

For the next two years, students from Smith will join Francisco students at the Layton Avenue, Francisco campus site. The District has leased two modular buildings for the site, adding 18 classrooms to house the students. Traffic will be challenging at the current Francisco site since both campuses will be learning together. We ask for your patience over the next two school years as we wait for the opening of the new campus on Haltom Road.

City staff at Haltom City have developed the following traffic pattern changes and posted signage around Francisco Elementary to ease the flow around the campus during arrival and dismissal times.

- x **One-Way Streets:** Hunter Street going east, Layton Avenue going south, and Jerri Lane going west will be one way around the campus (clockwise) at the following times:
 - ™ 7:40–8:40 a.m., Monday through Friday
 - ™ 3:05–4:05 p.m., Monday through Friday



- x **No Parking Areas:** On the school side of the street, there will be no parking on Hunter Street, Layton Avenue and Jerri Lane at the following times:
 - ™ 7:40–8:40 a.m., Monday through Friday
 - ™ 3:05–4:05 p.m., Monday through Friday
